- Facilitate, sing, and animate group and/or private sessions in a fun, engaging and beneficial way to keep the interest and focus of the participants.
- Demonstrate proficiency on guitar, voice, piano, and/or other instruments to meet client needs.
- Provide regular feedback to supervisors.
- Plan and prepare sessions appropriate to the population being served.
- Ability to pivot the music or activity and have Plan B ready when the participants need a change of pace.
- Adhere to a regular weekly schedule of music sessions which will be pre-determined.
- Inform supervisor of any class issues, feedback, updates or other important information.
- Communicate with your supervisor if there are any schedule changes.
